Kindergarten Round-Up for Irving will be held on Thursday, April 12 at 5:30 p.m. at Irving School. If you have a child who turns 5 on or before September 15, 2018 and you live in our Irving boundary, please plan to attend this event to register and welcome your child for Kindergarten. This event is for the incoming kindergarten student AND parents. Please leave other siblings at home. If you are unable to attend on April 12, please stop in the Irving Office to pick up your kindergarten registration materials before April 12. Staffing and section decisions are based upon your timely completion of this necessary paperwork so we know who is in Kindergarten within Irving's boundary.

An **enrollment survey** will be coming home in early April to verify where your child will be attending elementary school next year. Please complete and return that form quickly, as section decisions and staffing are being decided for next school year.

Spring Weather coming- Please send a jacket with your child on chilly days as our back blacktop playground area is quite <u>windy</u>. Keep a general rule of sending a jacket or sweatshirt option if it is about 65 degrees or below. Please also remember that we do NOT ALLOW FLIP FLOPS at school, and sandals must safely attach to the child's heel. Shirts need to have a shoulder strap that is at least one inch wide and no spaghetti straps are allowed for girls. Thank you for abiding by our dress code regulations.

Please remember to notify the Irving Office of any family address or phone number changes so that we have current information to contact families in case of an emergency or illness at school. It is very hard for the Health office or the School office to locate parents when we have only old phone numbers, wrong work numbers, and old addresses for parents. Thank you for your help in this matter! In an emergency situation, we NEED current contact information!

FREE Four-year-old Preschool- There are still spots available for FREE half-day preschool at Irving for next year. Children have to be age 4 on or before September 15, 2018 to enroll. Please stop by the Irving office 8:00-3:30 to get paperwork for this enrollment.

Those online applications were available March 15 on the district website, and are due on May 1, 2018 at 4:30 p.m. to The Forum for the Superintendent to approve or deny applications based upon class sizes at Irving.
